

TBI Therapy Post-Treatment Protocol

- I. Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy: 3 months or 25 sessions total

 Consider getting home unit from TBI Therapy or return to medical grade facility.
- II. Cranial Osteopathy: 1 session per week for 12 weeks total

 Patient should continue cranial therapy with a local provider (<u>find one here</u>): once
 a week or as their provider recommends.
- III. Intranasal Insulin: 10-21 days

Use every day for 10 days. If tolerated, it is recommended to continue use for 3 weeks then take a 1 week break. Contact TBI Therapy for a refill of insulin at your pharmacy.

IV. Brainwave Training Player: 12 weeks

Listen to 30 minutes a day for 12 weeks. If patients have abnormal mood changes while listening to the player, they should decrease to 1x/week and call Dr. Hughes for further instructions

- V. Nutrition / Supplements: 8-12 weeks
 - A. <u>Stem XCell by Enzymedica</u>: 2 pills 2x/day Continue 15 days after PRP or Stem Cell treatment
 - B. <u>Brain Octane by Bulletproof:</u> 1 tbsp 2x/day with meals Continue 12 weeks total
 - C. <u>Elk Antler by High Wire Ranch:</u> 2 pills 2x/day Continue 8 weeks total
 - D. <u>E3 Live BrainON:</u> 1 pill in am; 2 pills in pm Finish one bottle
 - E. Qualia by Neurohacker Collective: ONLY IF RECOMMENDED BY DR. HUGHES
 - F. <u>Mexidol</u>: ONLY IF RECOMMENDED BY DR. HUGHES or use two pills after drinking alcohol



VI. Ketogenic Diet: 3 months

- A. Consider intermittent fasting. Check out Bulletproof Intermittent Fasting.
- B. Use <u>Brain Octane</u>, start with 1 tablespoon daily and then increase slowly to 2-3x/day
- C. <u>Bulletproof Coffee</u> in the morning (in place of regular coffee) otherwise avoid coffee
- D. If you are going to do high heat cooking, use avocado oil, coconut oil, or grass-fed ghee.
- E. Make sure the meat you cook is not over-cooked. Cook it medium at most. Do NOT char or blacken.
- F. Good food choices: The <u>Bulletproof Diet Roadmap</u>, <u>Headstrong</u> by Dave Asprey, or Fat for Fuel by Dr. Joseph Mercola
